## **Criteria Definitions**

### Repertoire Effect

- Quality of Design How well the show has been designed to appear seamless..
- Range and variety of visual effects A wide range of visual design ideas are employed to create effect.
- Pacing The planning of effects such as builds, climaxes and resolutions through time that punctuate the performance.
- Coordination & Staging The way in which all elements are involved and work together to create a strong effect. All sections are staged for effective communication.
- **Visual musicality** The visual representation, reflection and enhancement of all aspects of the musical programme.
- Creativity / Imagination The design and coordination of efforts and effects in order to create mood and
  flow to a specific show, noting that a previously used idea presented in a new way can still be
  creative/imaginative.

### **Performance Effect**

- The band/corps evokes a genuine emotional response The performers bring the repertoire to life evoking an emotional response from the judge and/or audience. .
- Ensemble control and uniformity How the sections move as groups while maintaining form integrity, spacing and orientation. The demonstration of uniformity across, or within segments of, the ensemble.
- Showmanship / Expression Conveying emotional intent of the performance through visual design elements.
- **Professionalism and Competence** The ability of the performers to exhibit confidence, an understanding of their reponsibilities and a high level of excellence.
- Management of simultaneous responsibilities The extent to which performers successfully manage
  multiple visual tasks or combinations of visual and musical tasks.
