Criteria Definitions

Composition

- Involvement & Responsibility The way in which the repertoire allows all sections to take responsibility
 for their own part while ensuring they are fully intergrated into the whole. Creativity is used to produce a
 variety of effects.
- **Timing** The written music demonstrates an understanding of the tempos and accuracy required by the piece and the ensemble are able to reflect this through their performance.
- Variety The musical programme shows a variety and flair, using different rudiments, dynamics and tempos to enhance the overall musical programme.
- **Simultaneous Responsibilities** The written music shows consideration for the simultaneous mental and physical demands placed on the performer in terms of control of equipment, body control and movement.

Achievement

- Musicality Dynamics, balance, interpretation, clarity and control should be executed to enhance the
 performance and integrate with the whole.
- **Emotion** All performers should play dynamics, tempo changes, mood changes with control and balance and should convey musicality at all times.
- **Uniformity** All movements, both musical & physical, should be uniform & simultaneous, except where there is an obvious design variation.
- **Control** All players should play with control, and mastery of all rudiments, dynamics & tempo changes, ensuring balance across the section at all times, except where there is an obvious variation.
- **Precision** All players should perform the parts with precision and synchronicity, and demonstrate the ability to attack & release accurately as an ensemble.
